To support lecturers and the teachers enrolled on courses AIMSSEC invites applications for a three-month internship as a **Teaching Assistant**. The successful applicant will be offered a stipend, a return flight to Cape Town, shared accommodation in Muizenberg with other AIMS teaching assistants and researchers and all meals.

Duties:

- Office IT support, including but not limited to: monitoring and maintaining the computer systems and networks of AIMSSEC, conduct system backups, diagnose hardware and software faults and solve 1st tier technical and applications problems;
- Proof reading and formatting of study guides and assignments;
- Marking of mathematics teachers' content-based assignments;
- Teaching IT lessons during teacher training courses;
- Generating statistical reports to support monitoring and evaluation;
- Maintaining and improving the AIMSSEC online presence and updating social media content;
- Organizing and running fun mathematics activities in local schools.

Requirements:

- A degree in mathematics, statistics or computer science;
- Keen interests in mathematics teaching and the developing world;
- Excellent IT skills including generating statistical reports;
- Attention to detail, excellent communication skills and enthusiasm to work in a culturally diverse organization.
