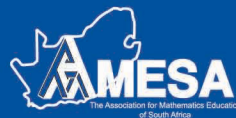

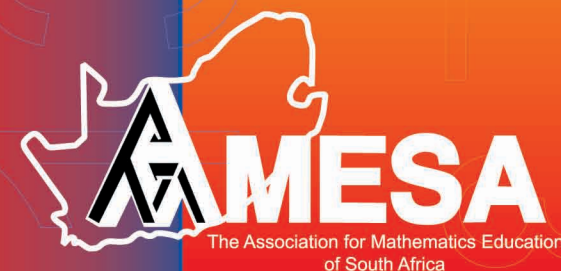

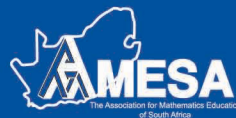


**AMESA** was founded in 1993 as the result of a unity process between nine previously divided Mathematics education organisations.

## **AMESA Activities:**

### **At national level AMESA:**

- ♦ Organises an annual Congress with international and local speakers.
- ♦ Publishes AMESA News keeping Mathematics educators abreast of events.
- ♦ Publishes Pythagoras and LTM, journals with teaching ideas, research findings and reviews of teaching materials.
- ♦ Is a co-organiser of the South African Mathematics Olympiad.
- ♦ Represents the interests of the Mathematics Education community on curriculum, policy and implementation and in various forums.
- ♦ Provides a forum for Mathematics educators to voice their opinions and concerns.

### **At provincial level AMESA:**
